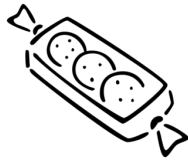

North Carolina, 2018:

Morgan Christopher's life has been derailed. Her assignment: restore an old post office mural in a sleepy southern town. Morgan knows nothing about art restoration, but desperate to be free, she accepts. Anna Dale, an artist from New Jersey, wins a national contest to paint a mural for the post office in Edenton, North Carolina. Alone in the world and in great need of work, she accepts. 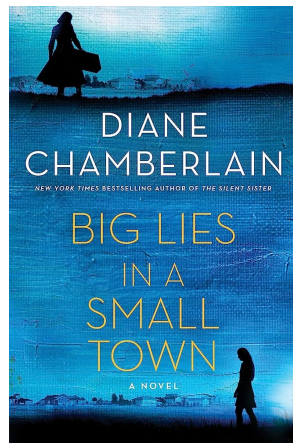

Registration for the 2024 Diocesan Holy Land Pilgrimage is now open! The pilgrimage will take place February 2-13, 2024 (with February 14th being a return travel day). The Very Rev. Ian S. Markham, Ph.D. and the Rev. J. Barney Hawkins IV, Ph.D., both of Virginia Theological Seminary, will be joining Bishop Cowden as our pilgrimage leaders. You will need to submit your passport information with your registration. To register, please check out the diocesan website, or contact St. Timothy's office.

### The Itinerary:

Day 1—Arrive in Tel Aviv, Israel

Day 7—Bethlehem & Environs

Day 2—Jesus' Glorious Public Ministry

Day 8—Jerusalem, City of Culture & History

Day 3—Ruins, Water, & Food

Day 9—Jerusalem the Holy City of the Messiah

Day 4—Nazareth & Sites of the New Testament

Day 10—Departure/The Jordan Journey

Day 5—Prayer & Lavishness in One Desert

Day 11—Petra

Day 6—Jerusalem the Holy

Day 12—Return to Israel

### The cost of the trip:

\$4,800 per person, sharing a double room with twin beds; for a single room there will be a supplement. Single supplement for single rooms: \$1,500. Bookings are processed on reception of a deposit of \$1,000 per person. Checks are made payable to: *Barney Hawkins (for Diocese of West Virginia Pilgrimage to Holy Land 2024)*.

### Included in the price are:

Accommodation at upscale hotels (Israel and Jordan), Airport assistance upon arrival and departure, Breakfast and dinner daily at hotels, Transportation using a deluxe coach (Israel and Jordan), Daily leadership and meditations, Professional English-speaking guides (Israel and Jordan), Entrance to all sites mentioned in your itinerary, "Whispers," so that the guide can be heard anywhere, Accommodations for the guides in Galilee/Tiberias, Jerusalem and Petra, Entry visa to Jordan - subject to change without prior notice--We secure visas, & 8 lunches

### Not included in the price:

Airfares (You can inquire about travel insurance, such as with Allianz Travel, to cover your flight and tour.), Gratuities for guides, drivers, porters, servers, Drinks, Medical insurance, or any kind of Covid 19 tests.

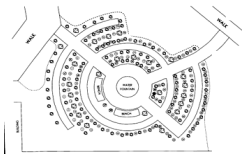
## College Contacts

## Reminder for Keyholders
