

Major Repair to the Lower Level

Many of you know that we have had (for years) a ground water issue in the UNDER CONSTRUCTION lower level- particularly in



the Gabriel Project Store. The heavy rains this spring and summer required us to do a permanent fix rather than just continuing to clean up. This required the Gabriel Project to move out for several months as the parts of the floor were dug up and drains were put in. A sump pump was installed and now captures that water and removes it outside.

Many thanks to Joyce Wilson who coordinated this project and did much of the physical labor of moving the Gabriel things out and preparing (cleaning and painting) the room to move things back in. Thanks also to Randy
