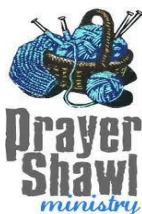

Major Repair to the Lower Level

Many of you know that we have had (for years) a ground water issue in the lower level— particularly in the Gabriel Project Store. The heavy rains this spring and summer required us to do a permanent fix rather than just continuing to clean up. A sump pump was installed and now captures that water and removes it outside.

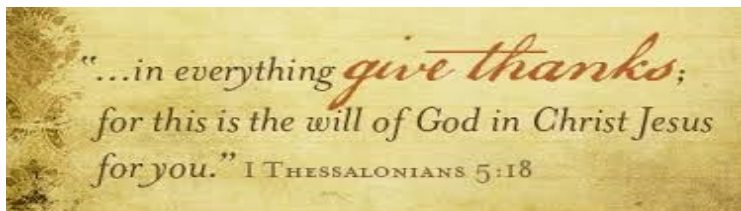
