

Billy Wayne's Garden



Morgan Christopher's life has been derailed. Day 7—Bethlehem & Environs

<u>Day 3</u>—Ruins, Water, & Food <u>Day 9</u>—Jerusalem the Holy City of the Messiah

<u>Day 4</u>—Nazareth & Sites of the New Testament <u>Day 10</u>—Departure/The Jordan Journey

<u>Day 5</u>—Prayer & Lavishness in One Desert <u>Day 11</u>—Petra

<u>Day 6</u>—Jerusalem the Holy <u>Day 12</u>—Return to Israel

The cost of the trip:
