


### Woman's Dinner and a Book Group

Kick off your Fall reading fun at the September meeting of Women's Dinner and a Book Group on Thursday, September 21st at 6:30pm in the Garrett Fellowship Hall. We will be discussing JoJo Moyes' book "Someone Else's Shoes".

Here's the scoop about the book from the jacket!

"Nisha Cantor and Sam Kemp are two very different women. Nisha lived the globetrotting life of the seriously wealthy until her husband inexplicably announced he wanted a divorce and cut her off entirely. Nisha is glamorous, fearless, and determined to hang on to the



life she has created for herself. But in the meantime, she must scramble to adjust to an entirely new landscape-she doesn't even have the shores she was, until a moment ago, standing in.

That's because Sam – at the bleakest point of her life – has accidentally taken Nisha's gym bag. But Sam hardly has time to worry about something as petty as a lost bag – she's struggling to keep herself, her out-of-work husband, and her sarcastic teenage daughter afloat. Or is it petty? When she tries on Nisha's six-inch high Christian Louboutin red crocodile shoes for a series of important meeting, the unexpected results give her a jolt of confidence that makes her realize something must change – and that thing is herself.

When the two women finally meet, they will discover that each needs the other to put right the wrongs that have been done to then – and to the women around them, from Nisha's enterprising colleague Jasmine to Sam's steadfast best friend, Andrea."

Full of JoJo Moyes' signature humor, brilliant storytelling, and warmth, "Someone Else's Shoes" is a moving, heartfelt story about how, for any of us, just one little thing can suddenly change everything.

There are several copies of the book available at both the Kanawha and Putnam/Cabell county libraries or you can check out either of the movies! You can find the book in paperback as well as Audio & Dooks at your favorite online or actual bookstore.
