

## Women's Dinner & A Book

Our final Women's Dinner & A Book meeting for 2016 will be held on Thursday, December 1, at 6:30 p.m. We will be discussing Geraldine Brooks' *The Secret Chord*.

"With more than two million copies of her novels sold, New York Times bestselling author Geraldine Brooks has achieved both popular and critical acclaim. Now, Brooks takes on one of literature's richest and most enigmatic figures: a man who shimmers between history and legend. Peeling away the myth to bring David to life in Second Iron Age Israel, Brooks traces the arc of his journey from obscurity to fame, from shepherd to soldier, from hero to traitor, from beloved king to murderous despot and into his remorseful and diminished dotage.

"The Secret Chord provides new context for some of the best-known episodes of David's life while also



focusing on others, even remarkable more and emotionally intense, that have been neglected. We see David through the eyes of those who love him or fear him—from the prophet voice of Natan, his conscience, to his wives Mikal, Avigail, and Batsheva, and finally to Solomon, the late-born son who redeems his Lear-like old age. Brooks

has an uncanny ability to hear and transform characters from history, and this beautifully written, unvarnished saga of faith, desire, family, ambition, betrayal, and power will enthrall her many fans."

Spiritual Surprises of Later Life


