**Sunday, December 25:** Christmas Day, No morning or evening worship services this day. 



### **Bishop's Visitation Offering**

When the Bishop(s) visits a congregation for an official visit, the loose offering goes to The Bishops' Visitation Offering Fund. Each year these offerings are designated to a special outreach ministry of the diocese. In recent years, the Reading Camps and Peterkin Scholarships have received these monies.
