Host Families Needed! Concert Goers Too!

The Grand View University Choir from Des Moines, Iowa, will be performing at St. Timothy's-in-the-Valley Episcopal Church on Monday, March 12 at 7:00 p.m. as part of its ten-day 2018 Spring Tour through Iowa, Missouri, Indiana, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, and New York. The tour program, New Life Will Grow, arises from the Lenten and Easter seasons as well as the springtime around us in nature. The Grand View Choir tours extensively throughout the United States as well as regularly in Europe and is praised for its excellence. St. Timothy's hosted this choir in March of 2014, and we're excited to have them back with us. Their concert will follow our Monday evening free supper.

Similar to the 2014 experience, host families are needed for the staff and students the night of March 12. There are 7 pairs of females, 1 single female, 4 pairs of males, a trio of males (with a cat allergy), and 2 staff members who can be housed singly or in combination. Pairs may be housed in 4's or 6's as well, depending on a host family's space availability. The responsibilities of a host family include attending the 7:00 p.m. concert (if possible), transporting your guests to your home, feeding them breakfast, preparing a sack lunch for them to take on the road, and transporting them back to the church by the morning check-in time. Gabriel Project








Women's Dinner & A Book

Holy Week and Easter at St. Timothy's



March 25th 10:30 and 4:30

The Palm Sunday Service (weather permitting) will begin in the Memorial Garden where we bless the Palms and process into the church to shouts of Hosanna in the Highest! The Service takes and abrupt shift as we hear the reading of The Passion Gospel and we focus on the Crucifixion of Christ. We will celebrate and receive communion to receive spiritual nourishment for our Holy Week journey.₩



Wednesday March 28th 6:30 pm

The word "Tenebrae" comes from the Latin meaning "darkness." The Tenebrae is an ancient Christian service that makes use of gradually diminishing light through the extinguishing of candles to symbolize the events of that week from the triumphant Palm Sunday entry through

Jesus' burial. This increasing darkness symbolizes the approaching darkness of Jesus' death and of hopelessness in the world without God. The service concludes in darkness, sometimes with a final candle, the Christ candle, carried out of the sanctuary, symbolizing the death of Jesus. A loud noise may also sound symbolizing the closing of Jesus' tomb. The worshipers then leave in silence to ponder the impact of Christ's death and await the coming Resurrection. №



Thursday March 29th 6:30 pm

On this night we gather to remember the commandment to "Love one another as He has loved us". We will gather at the table for Holy Eucharist, Strip the Altar in preparation for Good Friday, and hear the account of Jesus' Agony in the Garden. We leave the church in silence and prepare our hearts for the grief of the Crucifixion.
